With this folder we present to you Castila, our educational centre founded in 1988. We are thrilled with the idea that you may come to do a course with us and that you confide in us as a part of your linguistic education and cultural immersion. We would love to have the opportunity to teach you, along with Spanish, everything about Castila and its city, Granada, both an excellent example of Spanish life and culture.

During these last few years we have worked to adapt our curriculum to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). We have distributed the 6 different levels of the CEFR into 24 modular one-week programs, and we program another 6 when necessary. These programs are complemented with a dozen of other courses dedicated to specific subjects including professional, cultural, social and academic subjects.

We intend these programs to be a response to the specific needs of our students. We also intend to respond to the common questions: "How much time do I need to learn Spanish?", "How much will I improve during the weeks I spend in Castila?", "What is my current level of Spanish and how much time will I need to study to be able to take the DELE B1 or C2 exam?", or most importantly, "What should I study to be able to go to a university, live or work in a Spanish-speaking country?".

We have often heard our students say that "Castila is the best school to study Spanish," to which we always respond: "but no: as good as it will be next year."
