Program Summary

- 15 hours of class per week

- 1 outing to the beach (Saturday) organized by school collaborators/staff
- Lodging with Spanish families, double rooms, full board. Additional activities with host family: city, country, beach
- Full transportation from airport to host family and back to airport.
- Access to pool and sports facilities
- Access to study rooms and library

Objectives

To improve students' Spanish communication skills by combining classroom activities geared to young people with extracurricular activities appropriate to their age.

Description of the Program

A complete, rounded program that includes coursework, activities, and lodging. Students will be part of an international community of young people (including Spaniards) whose common language is Spanish. They will test their skills in different contexts of communication:

- With Spanish host families: with parents, siblings, and room-mates
 - In class, with experienced teachers who specialize in teaching young people and studying material appropriate to their age and level
 - Outside class: participation in carefully planned, well-supervised activities organized according to student interest and the communication goals indicated above

- Sports
 - Visits to must-see sights (the Alhambra and other monuments and places of socio-cultural interest)
 - Granada's richly varied natural setting: mountains, beach, countryside
 - Group soccer games including boys, girls and teachers; salsa classes; the opportunity to meet young people their age; making paella in the school courtyard...
