Attendance Certificate

Awarded by CastiLa, based on the hours and the course participation. 90% attendance is required.



Level Certificate

After taking the appropriate level tests, a student's competence level can be certified.



DELE

Issued by the Instituto Cervantes on behalf of the Spanish Ministry of Education, the DELE is the official qualification that certifies the level of proficiency in Spanish. There are 6 linguistic accreditation levels: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2.



Servicio Internacional de Evaluación de la Lengua Española

SIELE electronically certifies Spanish language proficiency, for students and professionals.



Commercial Spanish Diploma / Diploma in Spanish Tourism

Both certifications are awarded by the Chamber of Commerce and the student can take the exam when convenient for him/ her.



CCSE Test for Candidates for Spanish Citizenship

Official certification from the Cervantes Institute required to apply for Spanish nationality, which certifies that the applicant knows the basics of the Constitution, culture and society of Spain.



University credits (ECTS, European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System) are granted by the UDIMA (Madrid Open Distance University) for the intensive and specific purposes courses at CastiLa.



Most of the courses meet the requirements for obtaining scholarships and grants of Erasmus Plus (2021-2027) Key Action 1, new program offered by the European Union (Ka1 Current LLP, Life Long Learning Program).

Granada The beautiful city of Granada is situated between mountains and sea. Half an hour to the east is Sierra Nevada National Park, with some of the best ski slopes in Spain. Half an hour to the south lies the Costa Tropical, Spain's lush coastal region with warm Mediterranean waters, great beaches, and endless orchards of avocados, mangos, and papayas. Granada is the city of the Alhambra and the Generalife, the most visited monuments in Spain. Granada is also home to the Albaicin, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of the most unique neighbourhood in the world, and the location of CastiLa.

The Albaicín The writer, Antonio Gala, once said, "it was just as beautiful to look at the Albaicin from the Alhambra as it was to look at the Alhambra from the Albaicin". Apart from its historical significance, perhaps the most interesting aspect of the Albaicin is that it maintains its customs, traditional atmosphere, narrow streets, and the beauty of its *Carmens* (walled estates). From the Albaicin you will experience spectacular views of the Alhambra and the Sierra Nevada mountains. Walking through the narrow streets you will come upon quaint plazas, bustling markets full of color, and kind people.... The Albaicin is like a small town in the centre of a cosmopolitan city. In 1995 UNESCO designated the Albaicin as a World Heritage Site.



CastiLa Since 1988, we have been situated in the heart of the Albaicin. Originally in the "Carmen de los Gatos", and currently in the Casa San Nicolás, an International Education Building, in one of the most famous and valued squares of the world in the very heart of the unique and iconic neighbourhood of Granada, the Albaicin.

The Casa San Nicolás is a typical granadian house (called *carmen*) with office, classrooms, garden and space for activities. Close to apartments, public library, public school, cultural centre, market places, health centre, bars and restaurants, CastiLa enjoys a very genuine and cosmopolitan atmosphere with unparalleled views and urban landscape.

Our location is part of our commitment to share the Spanish experience in this traditional setting, offering the combination of language, culture, and Spanish customs. A privileged spot, right in the centre of the Albaicín and Granada where one can have a relaxed walk, enjoy flamenco, have a rest, learn, dream ...

Methodology

In order to determine the appropriate learning level and needs of each student, all students of CastiLa have a personal interview with a professor and take a written and oral exam. According to the results of the tests and the number of weeks of classes each student wants to attend, the teachers propose a learning plan with course objectives. We believe that it's important for our students to have a clear vision of the path he or she wants to take. The classes are interactive and all the necessary teaching elements are provided (books, videos, audio, etc).
