DELE: Diplomas of Spanish issued by the Ministry of Education. The Cervantes Institute administers the 6 levels proposed by the CEFR languages.

### Spanish Certifications Given by CastiLa



#### Attendance Certificate

Awarded by CastiLa, based on the hours and the course participation. 90% attendance is required.



#### Level Certificate

After taking the appropriate level tests, a student's competence level can be certified.



#### DELE

CastiLa can certify students according to the official accreditation scale given by the Department of Education in Spain. There are 6 linguistic accreditation levels: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2. There are 5 annual possible exam sessions throughout the year.



#### Servicio Internacional de Evaluación de la Lengua Española

SIELE is the certifies electronically the command of the Spanish language proficiency for students and professionals.



#### Commercial Spanish Diploma / Diploma in Spanish Tourism

Both certifications are awarded by the Chamber of Commerce and the student can take the exam when convenient for him/ her.



#### CCSE Test for Candidates for Spanish Citizenship

Both certifications are awarded by the Chamber of Commerce and the student can take the exam when convenient for him/ her.
